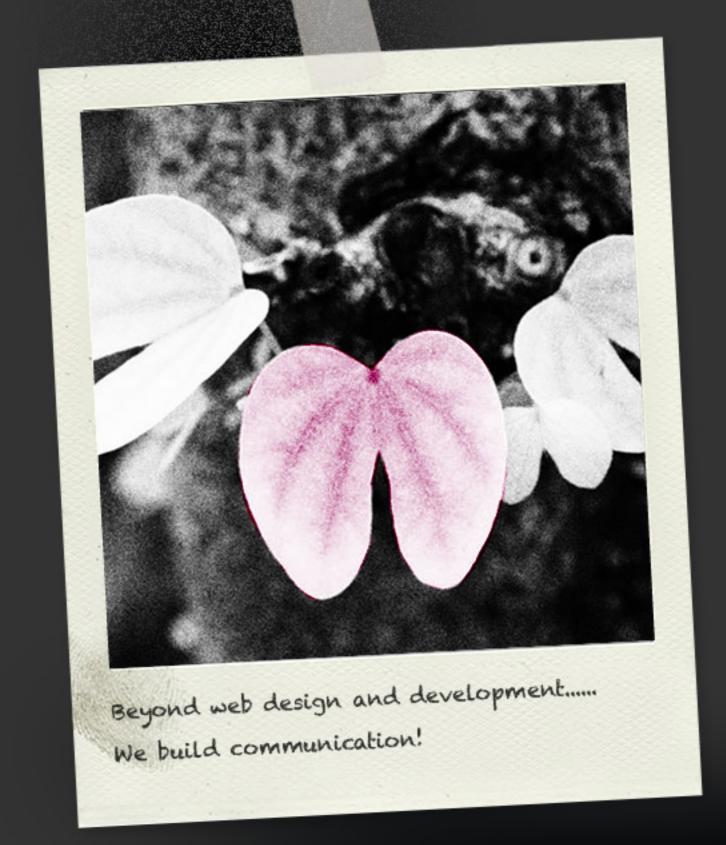

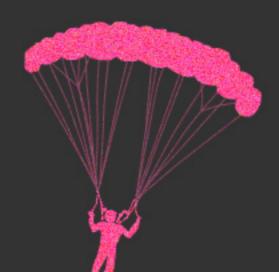


A bit about us

Challenge:

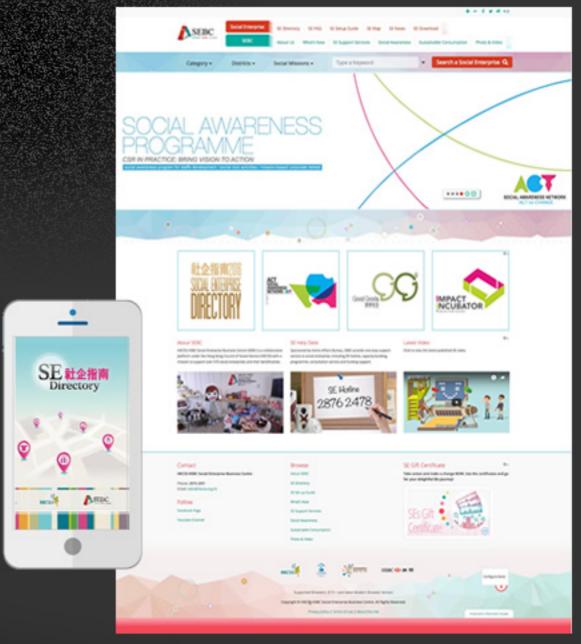

Along with the growth of Social Enterprise(SE) development, SEBC required a data-reconstruction on the SE database and need to build a collaborative data management system for HKCSS administrator and SE users. The SE data will implement the location based information and perform an enhancement on map search in mobile APP interface as well.

Solution:

Our solution enables SEBC to acquire a proven, deployed system that is integrate enough to suit their needs. Project delivery is supported by our proven project management methods, support and operational tools and techniques, and testing approaches and stability.

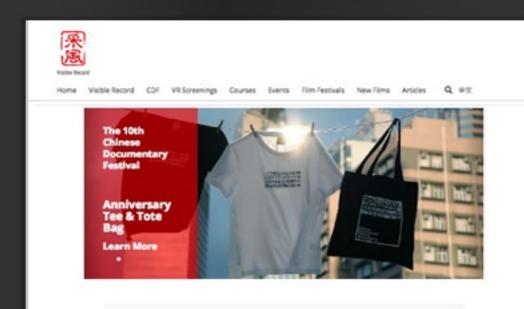

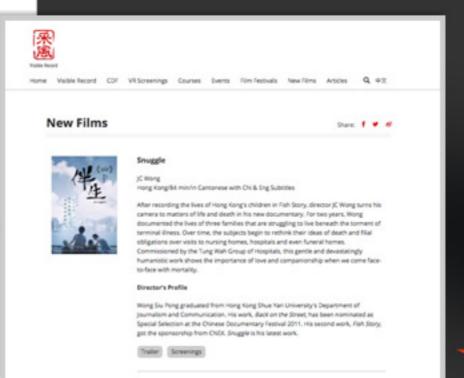

Collaborative online map platform

Client: Wherevergreen (former Greenmap.org)

Project: Build a collaborative online map platform with open

data infrastructure

Challenge:

Wherevergreen is a group of green and environmental lovers from all over Hong Kong, they have over 200 hundreds of members and District hosts, they required a scalable platform which will be efficient and flexible enough for their growing online Mapper community and to generate location based content by themselves. The next planning of the platform will likely to open the green data in the system for public to use, eg. to extent the data usage on an app for disabilities, so the backend structure has to be ready for open data and provide API or developer kit.

Solution:

Both parties spent plenty of time on platform requirements and usabilities with over 80 core members and committee members. The Server is set up and allows either upgrade or downgrade of system setting simply within a very short time without any interruption. There is various type of user accounts for volunteers, administrators, contributors and Wherevergreen staffs. The generated content is allowed to be output for further implementation and programming usage, API and documentation is provided

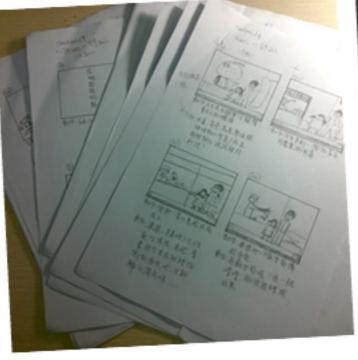




Multi-Media Communication

Client: Partnerships for Community Development (PCD)
Project: Animation on Community Supported Agriculture





Challenge:

PCD is a community development organisation on the promotion of sustainable living in China. One focus of their work is Community Supported Agriculture (CSA). CSA is a new concept in China and the client is seeking a solution to convey their message in a simple, interesting way to help people grasp the concept.

Solution:

We suggested to deliver a dynamic presentation in the form of animation. Animation is an attractive media with the combination of sound, movement and colourful visual elements, that can effectively draw people's attention and help people digest the concept without too much reliance on the text. It has a big potential to be spread through the social network on the internet.

Process:

To make the message more concise, only the key points should be presented in the animation. We met the client to get the concept of CSA and then we produced a storyboard which was the blueprint of the animation. It helped us review if the concept was accurately expressed and test user's experience when watching the animation. We then finalised the storyboard and went on with the full production. The whole process took us to research and discussion that Pixel Action regards highly in order to create effective communication.





Content Architecture

Client: Department of Geography, The University of Hong Kong Project: Luk Wu Oral History Project

Challenge:

The aim of this project is to compile the history and Buddhist culture in Luk Wu for educational purpose. The current website serves as an information archive. The client is seeking a way to connect the public to the information that seems daunting, and organize the research reports, videos and photos in a methodical way.

Solution:

We were engaged to re-design the website. Content structure and visual impression are the main design consideration. Since the reading experience among the target audience can be very different, it is important that the main points of each theme be delivered in the first instance. For that purpose, we made wide use of visual reference and produced flash presentation. A content management system (CMS) was also set up to provide a platform for easy updating and other web-based functions.









Process:

To have a better understanding of the client's needs, we studied the research information and also went to Luk Wu for site visit. Then, we drafted a site map that carried a reading strategy. We considered how to structure the content hierarchy and how to present the content to leave a sharp impression of Luk Wu on the visitors. We invited the research team and photographer to discuss the site map as we believed that each party in the project was closely related. We then made a prototype to help the research team visualize how the content would be presented, and also gave a clear guideline for the programmer to build up the CMS. This process reflects Pixel Action's equal emphasis on content architecture for effective communication.
